So you don't leave traffic (AND MONEY!!!) on the table

Reducing the size of your photos reduces how long it takes your website to load. Every second = more traffic and more conversions! Most people use images on their website that are over 1MB in size. We love photos that are 100KB or smaller. However, even for those images that cover the entire width of your site, best practice is to keep those photos under 300KB. At that size, images stay beautiful (even on hiresolution screens) while loading super fast!

This guide will walk you through the three steps to resize your images so you can shave seconds off of website load time.

- 1. Finding the large photos.
- 2. Resizing the large photos.
- 3. Compressing all your photos.


